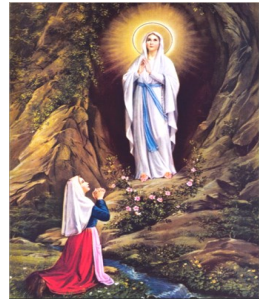

NOVEMBER IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS where we place the names of our deceased loved ones in the Frames that sit in front of the Altar.

During this time of COVID, I invite you to start making arrangements now to submit the names BEFORE the end of October to ensure that they are recorded. Envelopes for this Intention are in your boxes, however, a plain envelope so marked NOVEMBER is acceptable.

PRINT the name on an envelope (or piece of paper and put inside the envelope) and place it in the BOX or you may drop it off in the Presbytery letter box.

*Please limit the number of names and **PRINT CLEARLY**—we receive too many that are not legible and cannot be recorded for this reason.*
