**COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN UPDATE – SERVICE NSW REQUIREMENTS – KEEP SAFE AND PROTECTED:** With the virus, we still have to be cautious. The capacity for Churches is now 300, depending on size, so for Gymea, it is about 180. Where possible, still maintain a safe distance if possible, though the latest advice reflects only numbers in the whole area.

- ◆ *There must be "NO" entry to site if unwell*
- ◆ *All congregants MUST sign in by providing name and contact number – MUST BE CLEARLY PRINTED and one person per line and NOT grouped together*
- ◆ *All congregants are reminded that they should leave the Church after the service and not mingle*
- ◆ *All congregants are reminded to wear a mask*
- ◆ *All congregants are reminded of the requirement of 1 . 5metre rule for physical distancing*
- ◆ *All congregants are encouraged to wear masks during any service*
- ◆ *All congregants are asked to take their bulletin with them after Mass and NOT return them to the area where they are stored or leave them on seats*
- ◆ *Maximum number of people within the Church is 180 being 1 per 4 square metres*

**NEW B-POINT TAP AND PAY SYSTEM**

You will notice the new tap and pay DONATION machine at the entrance to the Church which was installed last Friday.

It accepts your Mastercard and Visacard (including Visa debit cards)

The DONATION is set at \$5 per Tap. If you wish to donate more, you simply wait until the machine is ready and you can tap again. You can tap as many times as you would like – each tap is a \$5 donation to the Parish.

**PLEASE NOTE:** That there are NO receipts (as they appear on your card's bank statement as Gymea Parish –GYMEA), also, there are NO refunds or tax deductibility.
